RESCINDING OF ANNEX VENTILATION UPGRADES AT WATCHUNG SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the Board advertised bids for the Annex Ventilation Upgrades Project pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-4 on two occasions; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2018 the Board received three (3) bids, and at the June 18, 2018 meeting they were rejected pursuant to 18A:18A-22(a); and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2018, the Board received nine (9) bids, and at the October 15, 2018 meeting the contract was awarded to Industrial Cooling Corporation ("ICC"); and

WHEREAS, after further review of the bid package submitted by ICC, it has been determined that same contained a material defect, mainly the failure to provide proof that they are prequalified with State Department of the Treasury, Division of Property Management and Construction ("DPMC") to perform the plumbing work outlined in the project manual, as required pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-18(b); N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-26; and

WHEREAS, such a defect renders the award of the contract to ICC on October 15, 2018 null and void; and

WHEREAS, the remaining responsive bids substantially exceeded the Board's appropriation for the Project; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-22, a board may reject all bids for various reasons as specified in N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-22;

BE IT RESOLVED that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board of Education approves the rejection of all bids because the lowest responsive bid exceeded the appropriation and the cost estimate for the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby authorizes the School Business Administrator to enter into negotiations for the project pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-5(c).
