2017 Estimated School Tax Levy Increase

- 2017-18 School Tax Levy \$112,471,548
- Increase of 2.32% from the prior year tax levy
- Increase would be \$44.59 for every \$100,000 of assessed home value
- For a home with an assessed value of \$500,000 the increase would be \$222.95
